*Implementing Guidelines for the Offering of the Co-requisite Courses for 2nd semester AY 2020-2021

(CHEM 18 and CHEM 18.1, CHEM 40 and CHEM 40.1, CHEM 43 and CHEM 43.1, CHEM 44 and CHEM 44.1, CHEM 32 and CHEM 32.1)

*These are applicable only to curricular programs that require both the lecture and laboratory components to be taken by the students. The co-requisite requirement is lifted temporarily during the time of COVID-19 pandemic.

The lecture (e.g. CHEM 18) and laboratory (e.g. CHEM 18.1) components of these courses may be taken concurrently. The student may also take the lecture before the laboratory component. However, the student cannot take the laboratory without taking first the lecture component.

If the lecture and laboratory components are taken concurrently and:

- a. If the student got a grade of "5.0" due to poor academic performance in either the lecture or laboratory component only, but passed the other component, the student shall repeat the failed lecture or laboratory component only.
- b. If the student applies for dropping in the lecture component only, the student shall be automatically dropped from the laboratory component.
- c. If the student applies for dropping in the laboratory component only, the student may proceed with the lecture component.
- d. If the student got a grade of "DRP" due to poor academic performance (akin to the rules adopted this 1st semester AY 2020-2021) in either the lecture or laboratory component only, but passed the other component, the student shall repeat the failed lecture or laboratory component only.
